## HELP WANTED

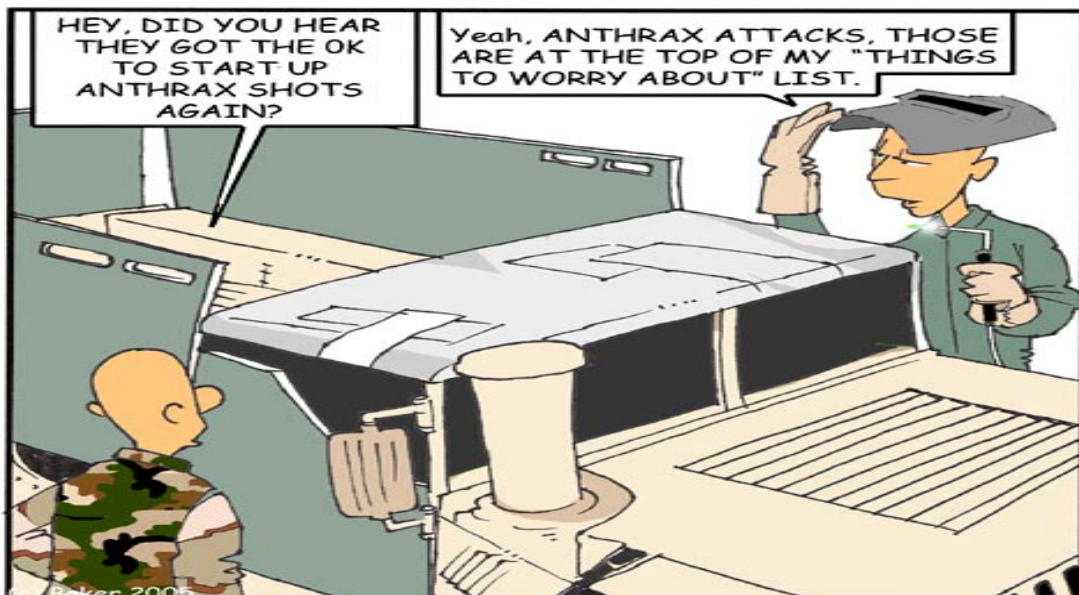

## ROTC MEDAL STATUS

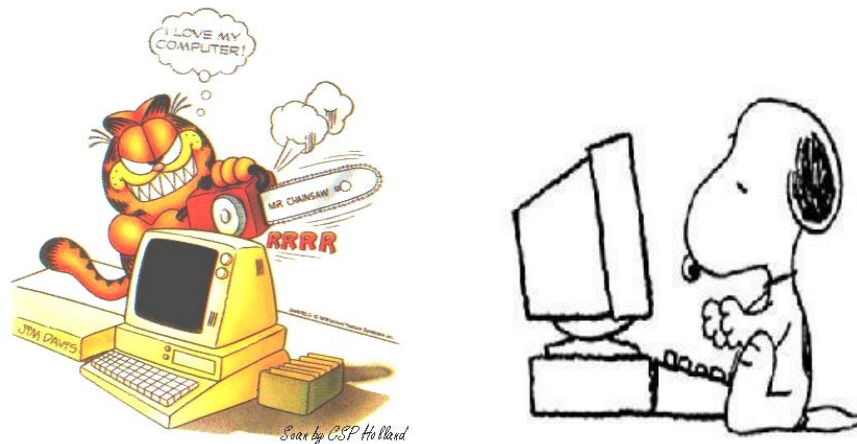

## MILITARY HUMOR

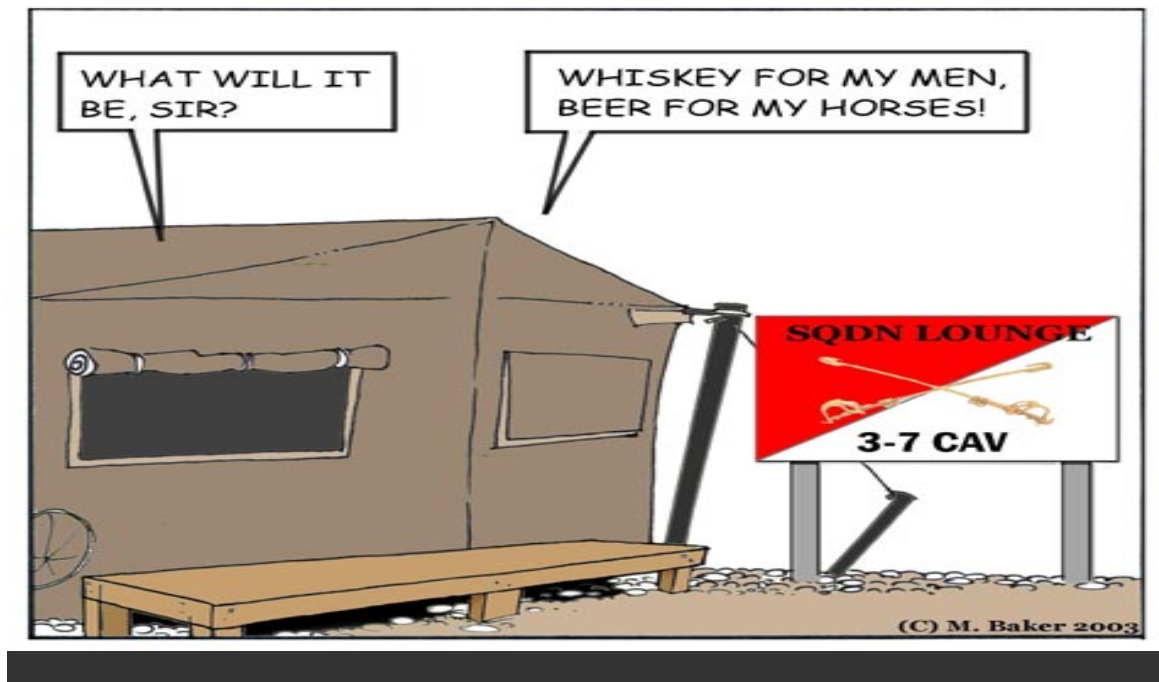
